



Moose Jaw & Area Trans Canada Trail:

Trail #: 08-0018

Trail Status: Operational

Location: Moose Jaw is located in southwest Saskatchewan along Highways 1 and 2.

Description: Starting on Coteau St. East, the trail winds its way around the Moose Jaw River and through the scenic Wakamow Valley ending on 9th avenue SW.

Historical: While difficult to pin down the exact history of the city's name, there are two main theories.

One theory is that Moose Jaw refers to a bend in the local river that resembles the outline of a moose's jaw.

The second theory suggests the name was derived from the Cree word *moosegaw* which translates to "warm breezes." Situated in a valley, the city is generally a few degrees warmer than other communities in the region.

Terrain: Urban trail

Difficulty: Easy

Signage: Trans Canada Trail markers are found along this section of trail.

Trans Canada Trail Pavilion: Near the intersection of Coteau St. East and the Moose Jaw and Area Trans Canada Trail.

Facilities: A full list of facilities and services is available along or near this section of trail.

Points of Interest: Western Development Museum, Temple Gardens Mineral Spa, Casino Moose Jaw, Yvette Moore Gallery, Tunnels of Moose Jaw, Buffalo Pound Provincial Park

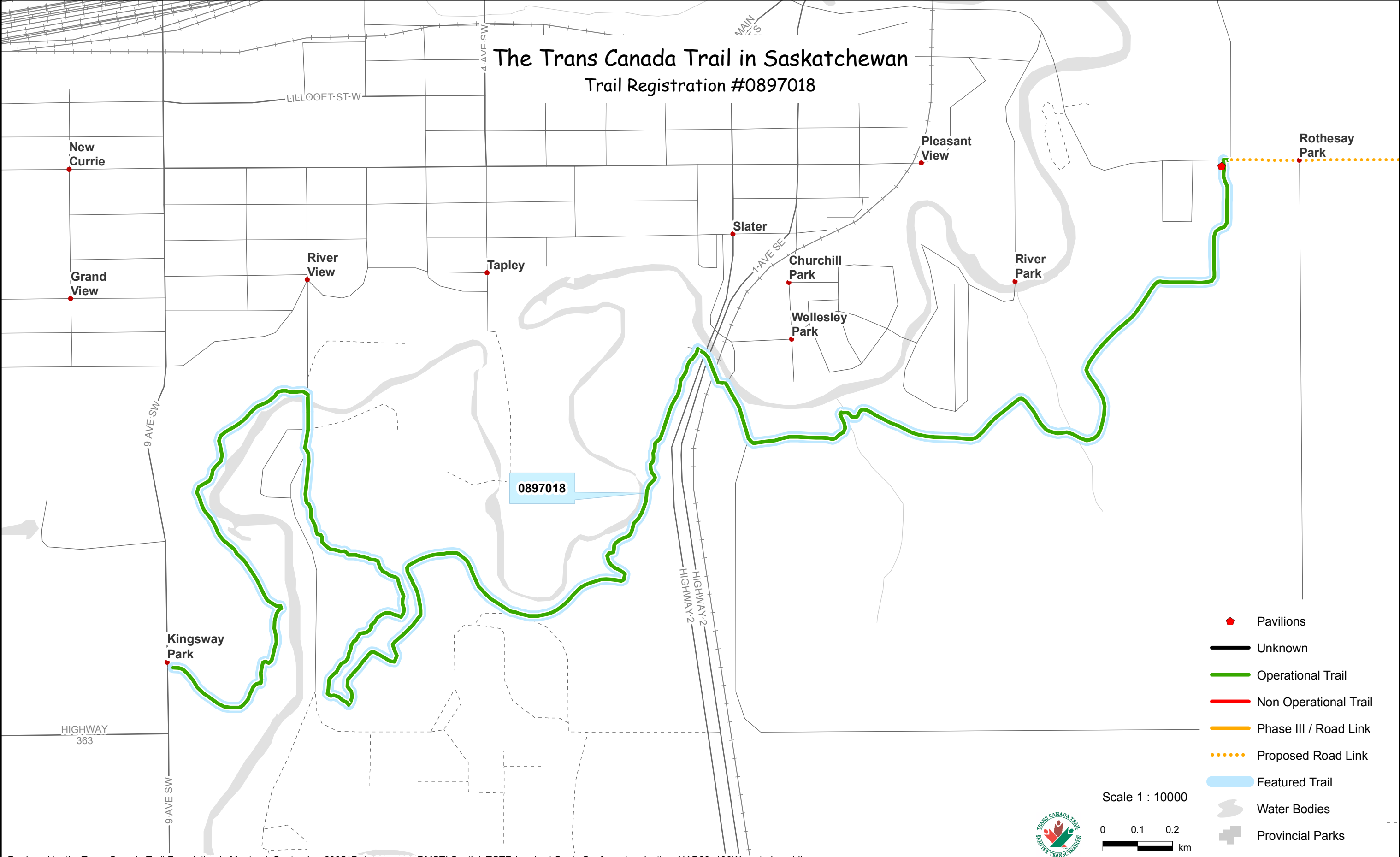
