



Crooked Lake Trans Canada Trail:

Trail #: 08-0012

Trail Status: Operational

Location: The Crooked Lake Trans Canada Trail is located in southeast Saskatchewan along Highway 247.

Description: Found within the Qu'Appelle Valley, this section of trail runs along the northern shore of Crooked Lake Provincial Park and then travels through the village of Marieval towards the Shesheep Indian Reserve of the Sakimay First Nations.

Historical: Legend says that a young man was returning to his village late one night when he was startled by the sound of someone calling his name. He called out into the darkness in Cree, "Ka-tepwet?" When there was no answer, he called out again in French, "Qu'Appelle?" or "Who calls?" Again, there was no reply.

The next morning, upon arriving in his village, the young man discovered that his bride-to-be had died suddenly in the night. With her last words she had called out his name.
