



### **Two Rivers Trail East:**

**Trail #:** 08-0013

**Trail Status:** Operational

**Location:** Kamsack is located in southeast Saskatchewan along Highway 57.

**Description:** The Duck Mountain Trail becomes the Two Rivers Trail upon leaving the provincial park. Heading east, the trail briefly enters the town of Kamsack before continuing on towards the village of Veregin.

**Historical:** Settlement of the area now known as Kamsack began in the late 1800's. Settlers from across the United States and Canada arrived into the area; however, the largest ethnicities remain Doukhobours, Ukrainians, and Russians.

While Kamsack was slowly rebuilding from the Great Depression, tragedy struck. In 1944, the town was devastated by a cyclone that destroyed over 500 homes and businesses.

**Terrain:** Rural trail

**Difficulty:** Easy, mainly flat, although some steep segments

**Signage:** Trans Canada Trail markers are found along this section of trail.

**Trans Canada Trail Pavilion:** None

**Facilities:** A full list of services and amenities is available in the community of Kamsack.

**Points of Interest:** Kamsack & District Indoor Rodeo, the Kamsack Outdoor Swimming Pool, Duck Mountain Provincial Park.
