Location: The community of Sandy Beach is located in southeast Saskatchewan along Highway 56.

Description: This section of the Trans Canada Trail travels along the eastern cost of Fishing Lake through the town of Katepwa and Katepwa Point Provincial Park into the village of Sandy Beach and then on to the town of Labret.

Historical: The resort communities of Katepwa Beach, Katepwa South, and Sandy Beach lost their village status in 2004 due to declining populations. Subsequently, the communities were reorganized and are now known collectively as the District of Katepwa.
