



**Meewasin Valley Trail:**

**Trail #:** 08-0023

**Trail Status:** Operational

**Location:** The city of Saskatoon is located in central Saskatchewan along Highways 11, 14 and 16.

**Description:** This section of the Trans Canada Trail is located in the heart of Saskatoon along the South Saskatchewan riverbank.

An extension to the current trail is currently under development.

**Historical:** With the dream of building a community free from the evils of liquor, a group of 3,100 settlers from Toronto's Methodist community, calling themselves the Temperance Colonization Society, arrived along the banks of the South Saskatchewan River in 1883.

The settlements of Nutana and Riversdale soon followed, which then amalgamated into the village of Saskatoon in 1901.

The Meewasin Valley Authority was created in 1979 to manage and develop the Saskatoon riverbank.

**Terrain:** Urban trail

**Difficulty:** Easy, although some steep segments.

**Signage:** Trans Canada Trail markers are found along this section of trail

**Trans Canada Trail Pavilion:** In Gabriel Dumont Park, near the intersection of 8th Street and Saskatchewan Crescent.

**Facilities:** A full list of facilities and services is available along or near this section of trail.

**Points of Interest:** Mendel Art Gallery, Wanuskewin Heritage Park, Western Development Museum

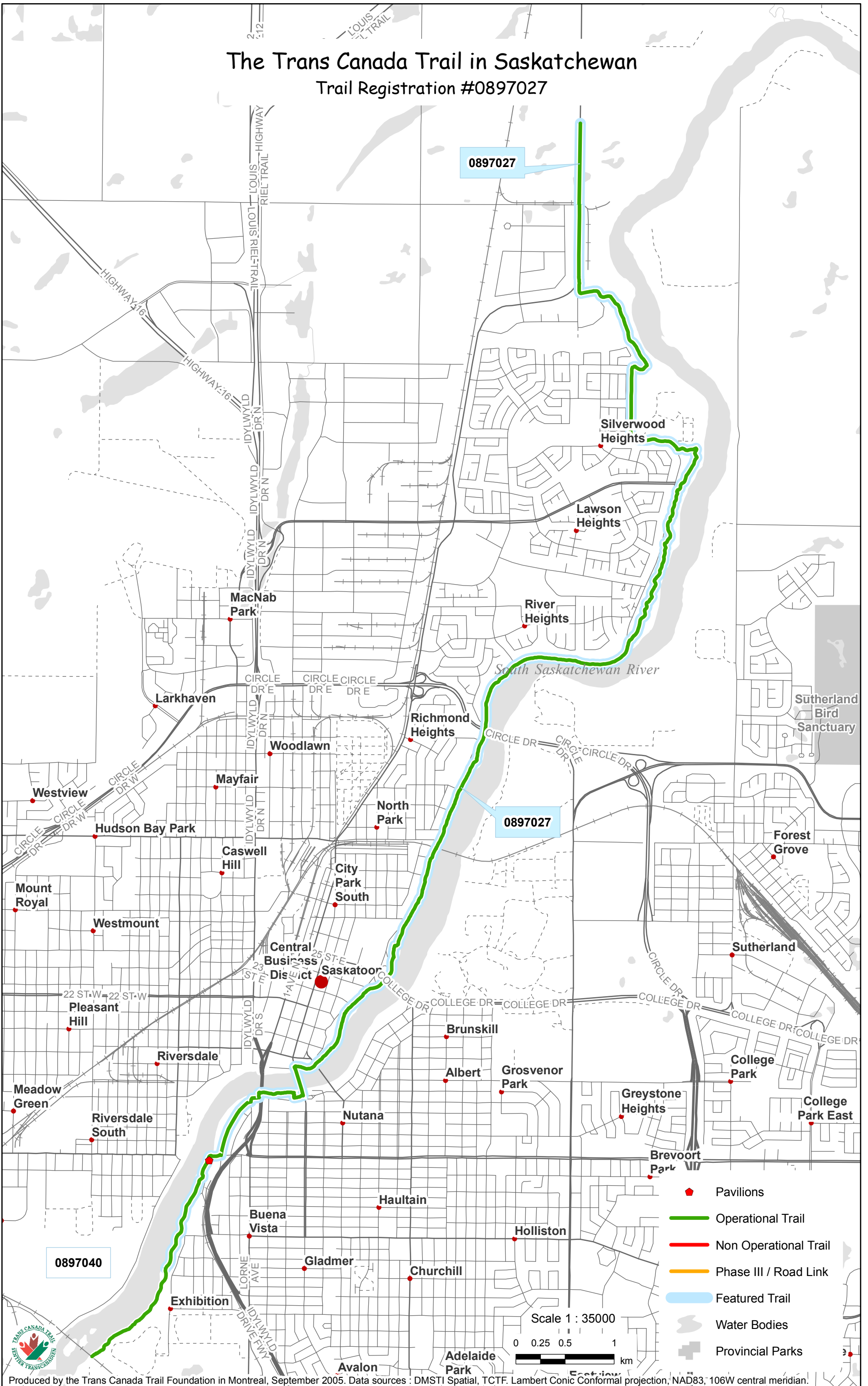
