



St. Walburg Trans Canada Trail:

Trail Status: Operational

Location: The town of St. Walburg is located in west central Saskatchewan along Highways 3 and 26

Historical: Perhaps the most famous resident of St. Walburg is Count Berthold von Imhoff, a German noble who immigrated to Saskatchewan in 1913.

As an artist, Imhoff sought to escape the rapid industrialization of Europe and the North Eastern United States. Enchanted by the prairie landscape and wildlife, he settled in St. Walburg to focus on his art.

A prolific painter, Imhoff refused to sell his any of his collection, which is still in his family's possession to this day and can be viewed at the Imhoff Art Museum.

Imhoff received a knighthood in the Order of St. Gregory the Great from Pope Pius XI in 1937 for his work within the catholic community of Saskatchewan.

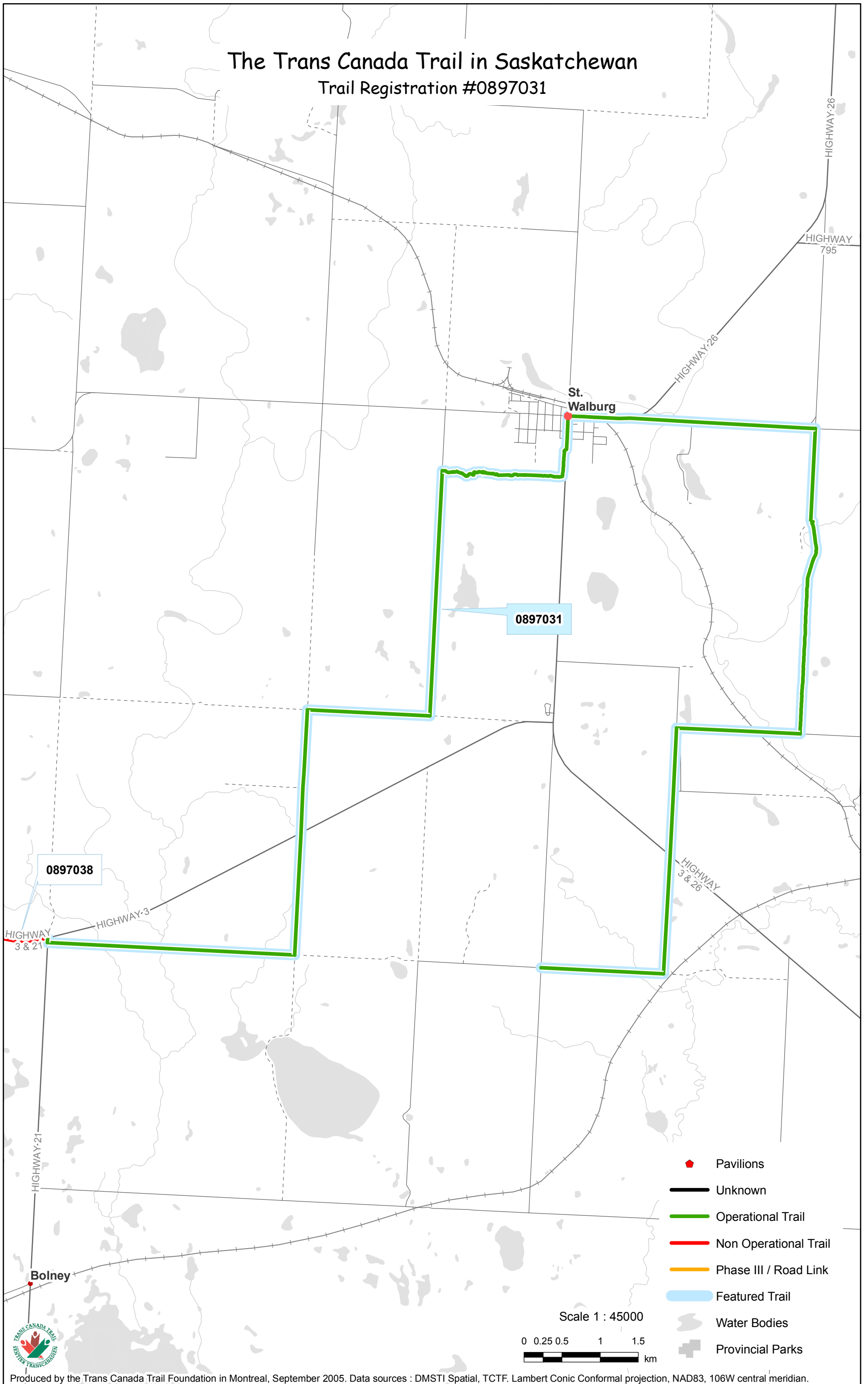
