



Tansi Trans Canada Trail:

Trail Status: Operational

Location: Fort Qu'Appelle is located in southeast Saskatchewan along Highway 10.

Description: This section of the Trans Canada Trail is found within the town of Fort Qu'Appelle, which is located between Echo Lake and Mission Lake.

The name of this section of the Trans Canada Trail, *Tansi*, comes from the Cree language and can be translated as "Hi, how are you?"

Historical: Legend says that a young man was returning to his village late one night when he was startled by the sound of someone calling his name. He called out into the darkness in Cree, "Ka-tepwet?" When there was no answer, he called out again in French, "Qu'Appelle?" or "Who calls?" Again, there was no reply.

The next morning, upon arriving at his village, the young man discovered that his bride-to-be had died suddenly in the night. With her last words, she had called out his name.

Terrain: Urban trail

Difficulty: Easy, mainly flat

Signage: Trans Canada Trail markers can be found along this section of trail.

Pavilion: Near the Fort Qu'Appelle Museum on Bay Avenue North.
